



The **Childress Rotary GREENBELT BOWL ALLSTAR CLASSIC** began in 1949 and has continued uninterrupted for 60 years. The game will be played in Childress, Texas at Bobcat Stadium on Saturday, June 13th at 7:00 p.m. Past players and coaches include Dewayne Miles, Mike Hargrove, Grant Taeff, Darryl Royal, Bud Wilkerson and Don Carthel. The purpose of the game is to provide an opportunity for scholarship money. There will be thousands of dollars in scholarship money awarded to players after the game. Additionally, several colleges will be at the game to scout players. Many players are awarded scholarships to continue their education from these universities.

The Greenbelt Bowl selection committee receives hundreds of applications from head coaches from the panhandle, as far south as Lubbock, north into Wichita Falls and southwestern Oklahoma. Classifications from 5A all the way to 6-Man schools are represented. The selection committee will then nominate approximately 68 players to fill rosters for two complete squads.
