

## **SUGGESTED CLOTHES AND ITEMS TO BRING CAMP RYLA**

Lone Tree Bible Ranch is a very fine summer camp facility in the foothills of Captain Mountain in New Mexico. The days can be very warm and the evenings cool. It is suggested that you bring a light jacket for evenings just in case. Daytime highs range in the 80's. Shorts and T-shirts are appropriate. You should bring at least one nice outfit such as jeans and nice shirt. There are many activities such as horseback riding and climbing for which you might prefer jeans as well. Most attendees change two to three times a day. The agenda consists of morning activities and speakers in the main meeting hall, lunch, afternoon athletic activities outdoors and evening activities and speakers in the main meeting hall. Please limit your luggage to ONE bag or duffle bag and your bedding. Monday and Friday are mainly travel days so wear something comfortable. You will not need to change clothing on those days. Housing consists of bunk houses with bunk beds. You will have community bathrooms.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Pair of shoes (You will need at least one pair of tennis shoes. Please NO heels ladies. If you bring sandals make sure they are suitable for rough terrain and/or mud)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hat (You will get a baseball style cap with RYLA logo)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Light rainproof jacket
- \_\_\_\_\_ Kleenex
- \_\_\_\_\_ Flashlight
- \_\_\_\_\_ pen/pencil and 1 ½" three hole notebook with notebook paper
- \_\_\_\_\_ insect repellent
- \_\_\_\_\_ camera and film
- \_\_\_\_\_ water bottle
- \_\_\_\_\_ change – phone (very limited access); sodas; ping pong balls
