About The Rotarian

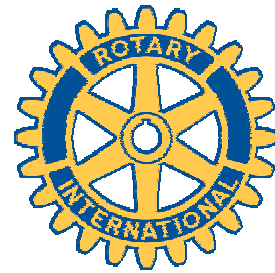
