Thank you and the Midland Westside Rotary for the \$500 donation to Midland Need to Read. This donation will be used for the Midland Need to Read programs that promote literacy.

In 2006, Midland Need to Read's trained volunteers met with 383 adult learners who improved their literacy and English skills. In addition to the one-to-one tutoring, computerized instruction, and phonic tape instruction, small classes are also offered. Midland Need to Read distributed over 714 workbooks, materials, and children's books to the adult learners in our program.

Excerpt from District Convention Report from Governor Roger Sepulveda

Talk about Rotarians who do good work....we gave out 177 club awards and recognition certificates, recognized one new Bequest Society member, recognized Borger and Midland Daybreak as 100% PHF Clubs, recognized four Major Donors, and presented three new PHF's. At the beginning of the 2006-2007 year when we kicked off the Paul Harris Society, I set a personal goal of 50 PHS members and since last weekend we have now exceeded that goal. The Silent Auction successfully raised \$2650. Foundation giving this year has been excellent! I commented we should be named the "**Action District**", because District 5730 is where the action is as we continue to "**Lead the Way.**" Congratulations to our Rotarians for rising to the occasion.

Diabetic Camp will celebrate its 28th Anniversary this year. Camp will be held at Ceta Glen Christian Camp outside of Happy, Texas, June 25-30, 2007. Children ages 7-14 suffering from Diabetes Mellitus are eligible for camp. Young adults and teenagers over the age of 15 with diabetes are eligible to be counselors and junior counselors.
